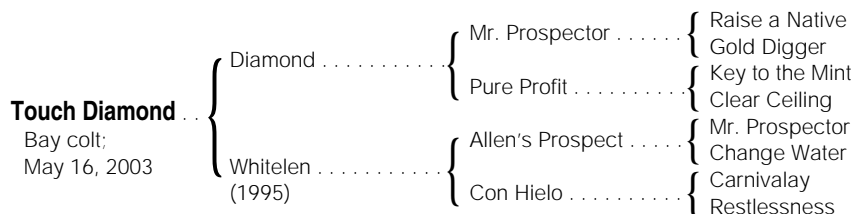

CON HIELO, by Carnivalay. 4 wins at 3 and 4, \$25,021. Dam of 5 other foals, 4 to race, 3 winners-- Rangeley Rebel. 6 wins, 3 to 5, \$57,558. My Other Sock. 5 wins at 3 and 6, \$38,342. Buffed Ice. Winner at 4, \$8,380.

RESTLESSNESS, by Restless Native. Unraced. Dam of 5 other foals, all winners-- Fallston. 11 wins, 3 to 7, \$51,054. Arctic Native. 3 wins at 3 and 4, \$27,240. Sire. Country Dawn. 2 wins at 3, \$18,481. Rangeley Native. 5 wins at 3, \$17,483. Restless Wolf. Winner at 3.
