THINKING OF YOU

Twice group placed, Thinking of You is a sister to 2022 group one winner Above the Curve, out of a half-sister to Giant's Causeway, from a stellar classic family. A daughter of one Triple Crown winner, American Pharoah, she is offered in foal to another, Justify.

A debut winner over six furlongs at debut, Thinking of You gained black-type on her second outing, taking third in the Park Stakes (G3), beating group one winner No Speak Alexander and group winner Keeper of Time. She went on to add further black-type credits at three, with a third in the Irish 1,000 Guineas Trial (G3), ahead of group winner Acanella and stakes winners Fantasy Lady and My Generation, and the Cairn Rouge Stakes, beating group winner Acanella again and stakes winners Holy Golightly, Friendly and Sweet Gardinia.

Thinking of You is by American Pharoah, the only horse to win the Triple Crown and Breeders' Cup Classic (G1). American Pharoah has rapidly established himself as an outstanding international sire. From his first four years at stud, he already has 30 stakes winners, with group or graded stakes winners in seven countries, including Champion European Two-Year-Old Van Gogh, and group/grade one winners Cafe Pharoah, As Time Goes By, American Theorem, Harvey's Lil Goil, and Above the Curve.

The last mentioned of these, Above the Curve – a sister to Thinking of You – proved herself one of the best three-year-old fillies in Europe when taking the Prix Saint-Alary (G1) on her most recent start this year.

Thinking of You and Above the Curve are out of the Galileo mare, Fabulous, who is also dam of a two-year-old filly by Justify, a yearling filly by Justify, a colt foal by Justify, and who is bred back to that horse.

Fabulous is half-sister to the famed 'Iron Horse' Giant's Causeway, not only a European Champion on the racecourse, but also a three-time Leading Sire in North America. In addition, Fabulous is half-sister to the group two winning and

group one placed You'resothrilling, the dam of Gleneagles, winner of four group one events, including the 2,000 Guineas (G1) and Irish 2,000 Guineas (G1); Champion European Two-Year-Old Filly Happily; Prix de Diane-French Oaks (G1) heroine Joan of Arc; Irish 1,000 Guineas (G1) victress Marvellous; group winners Taj Mahal and Coolmore; and classic placed Toy and Vatican City. Note that each of these eight horses are by Galileo, so three-quarters related to Fabulous. Fabulous is also half-sister to Pearling, the dam of another outstanding Galileo product in Decorated Knight, successful in the Irish Champion Stakes (G1), Tattersalls Gold Cup (G1) and Jebel Hatta (G1), and three-quarters sister to the dam of Storm the Stars, a group winner who placed in both the English and Irish Derby (G1).

This superbly-bred filly is offered carrying her first foal, a colt or filly by Justify, the only Triple Crown winner to retired undefeated. Justify's first crop are two-year-olds of 2022, and he is already off to a sensational start with four stakes winners, three group or graded, as well as several very promising maiden winners, and here the mating is rated *A++* by *TrueNicks*.
